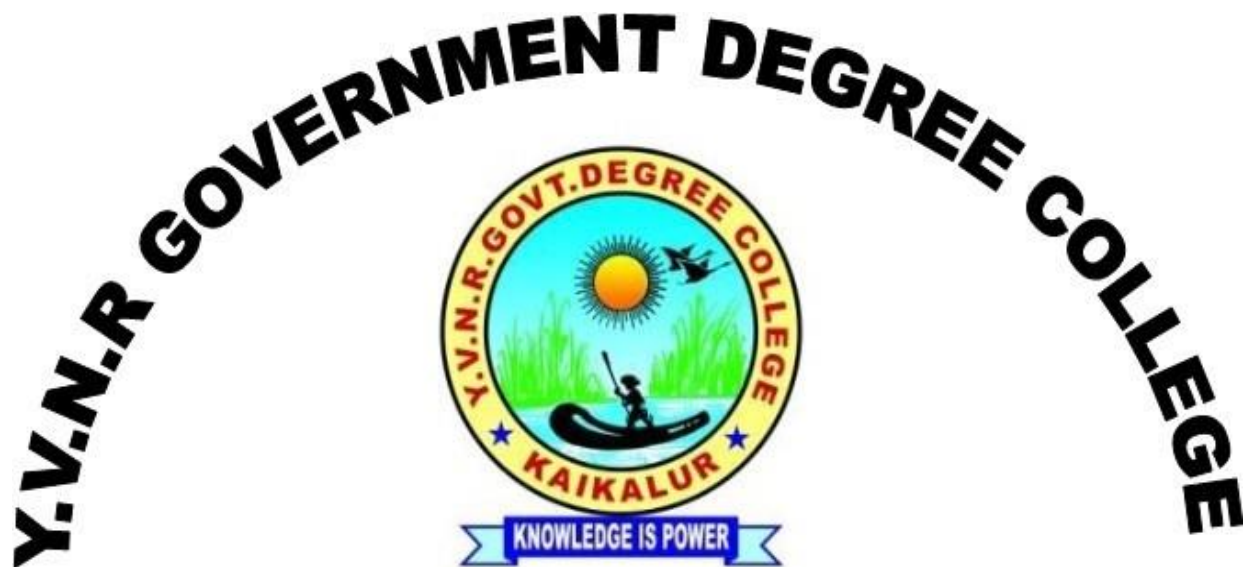

Day -4 (18/11/2022)

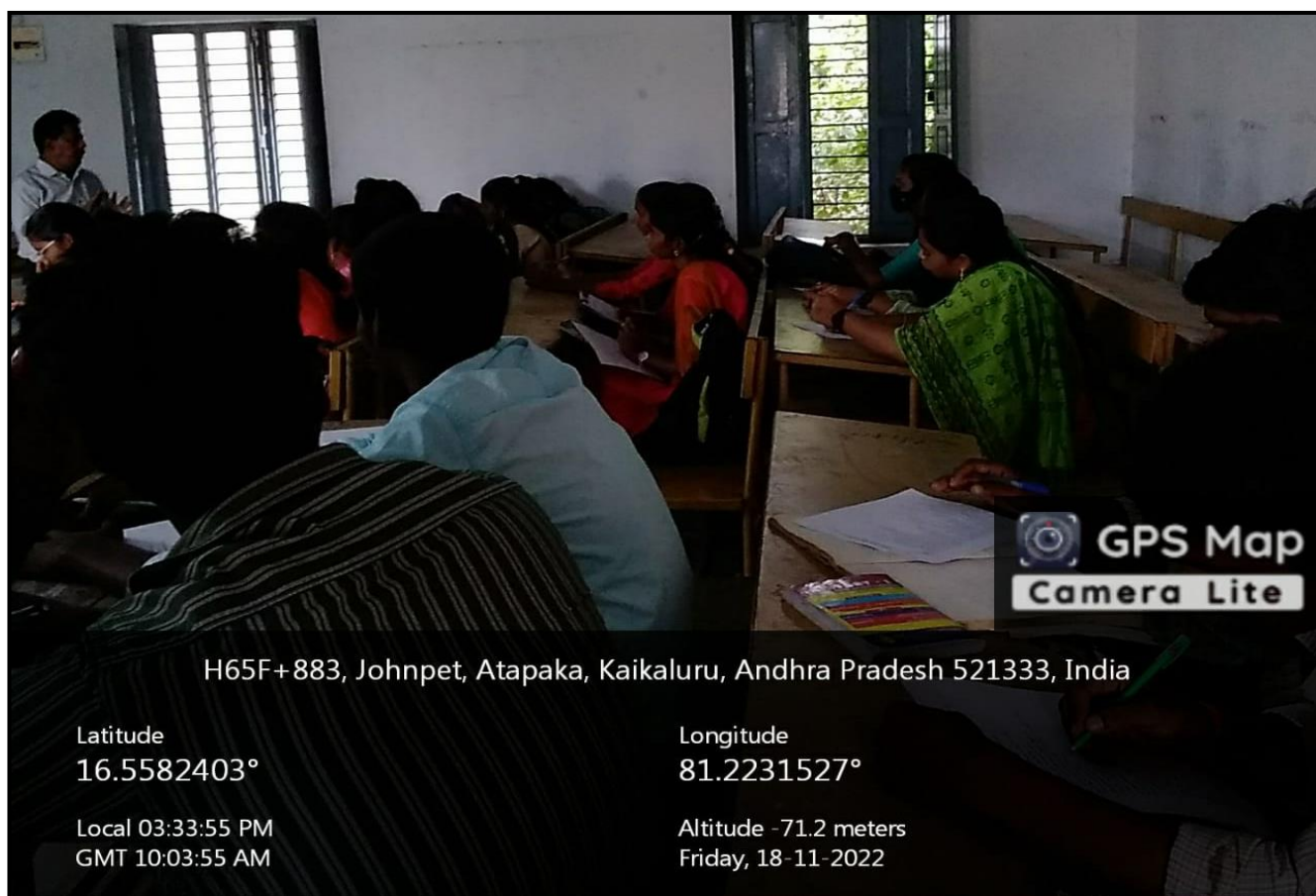

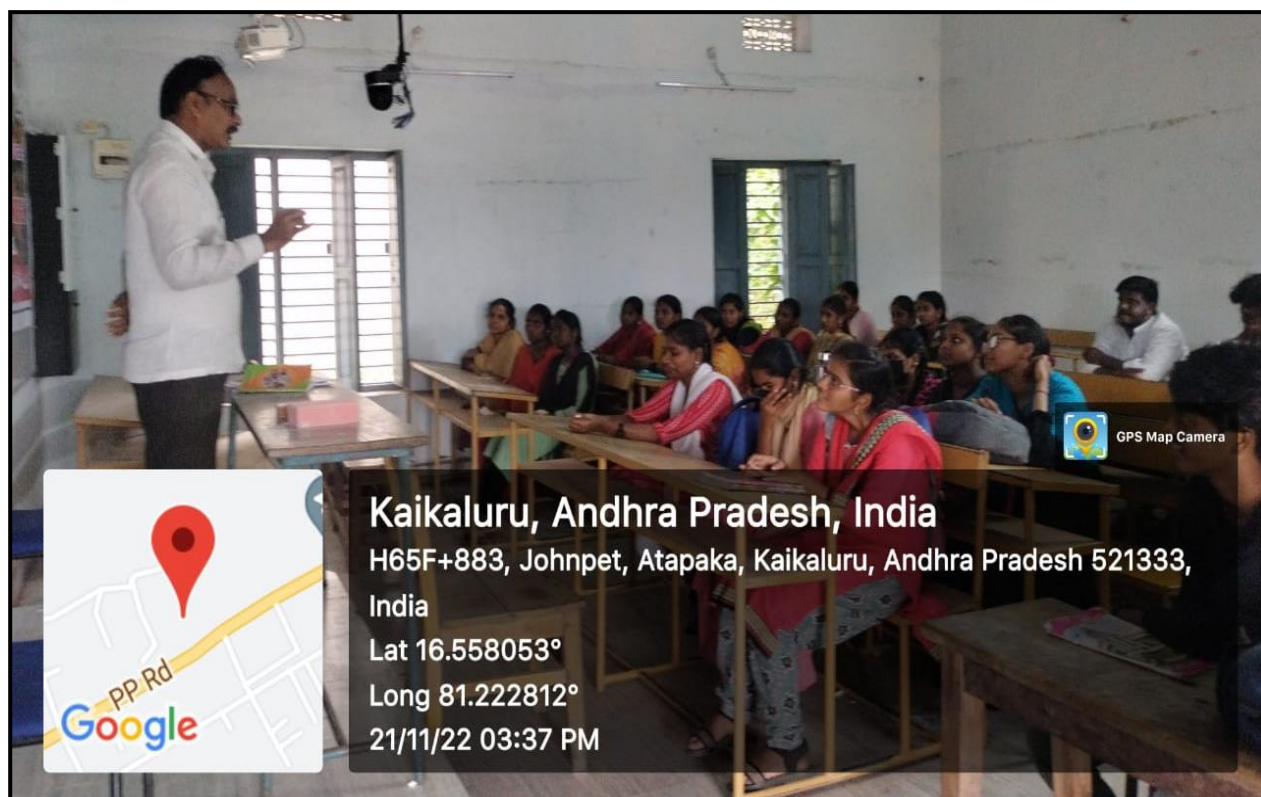

Day -9 (24/11/2022)

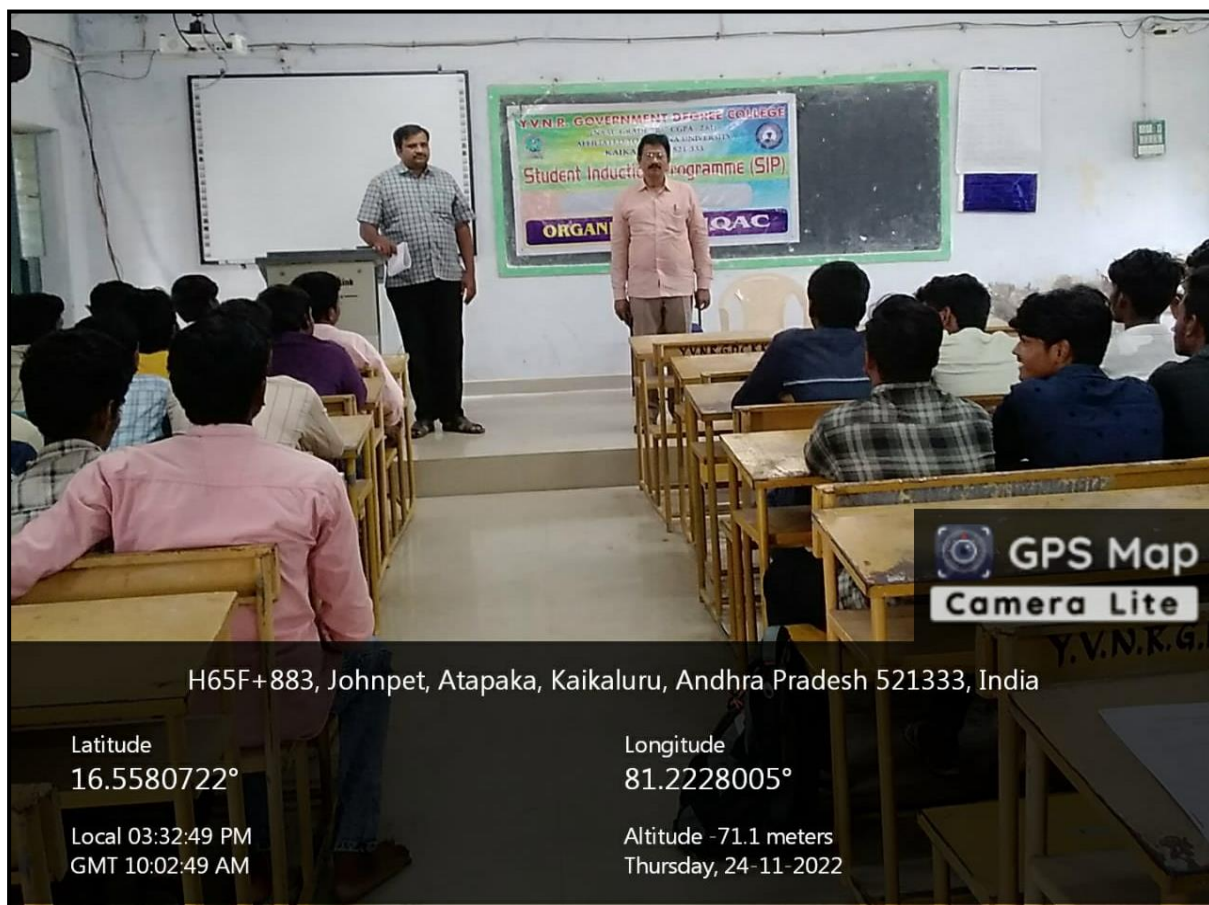

In continuation of his lecture, Dr Babu has explained various multiple options available to enhance the skill set of students to cope up with the competition.



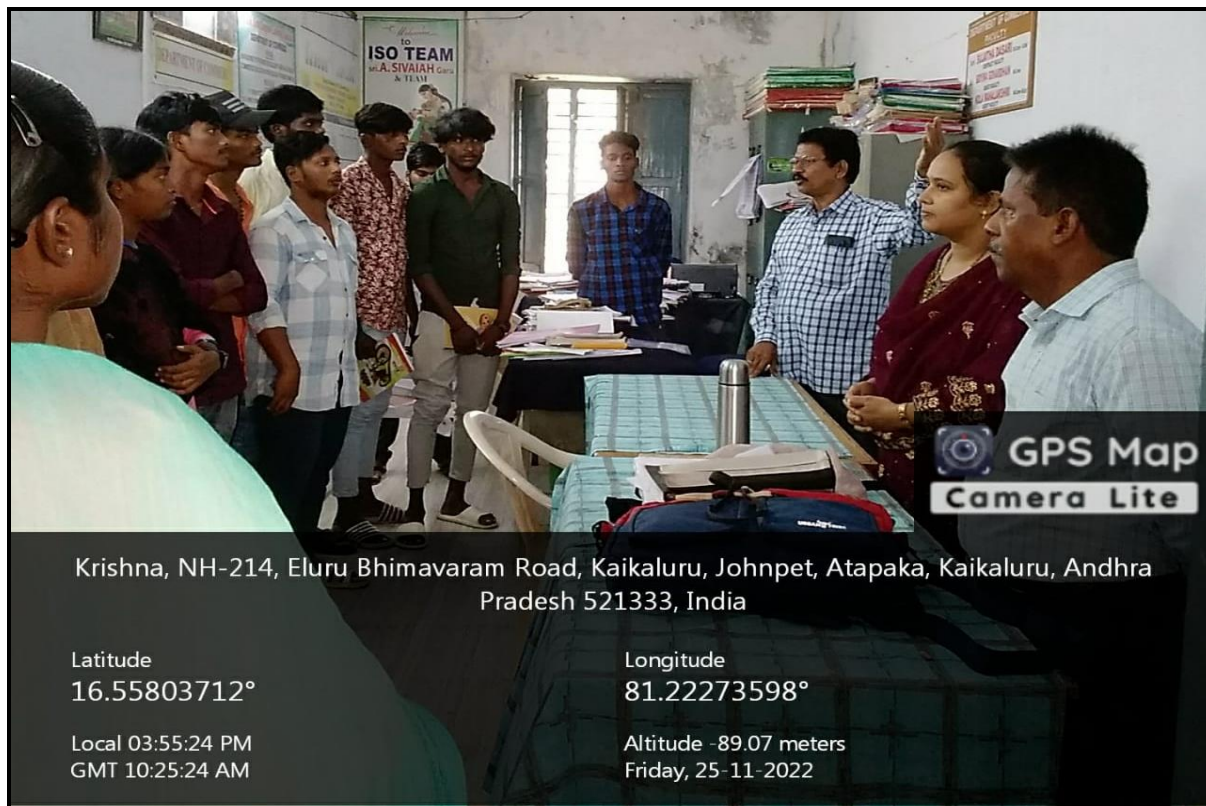
Day -10 (25/11/2022)

Before concluding the session, the students poised doubts about the CSP and Internship and got clarified them by the coordinators.



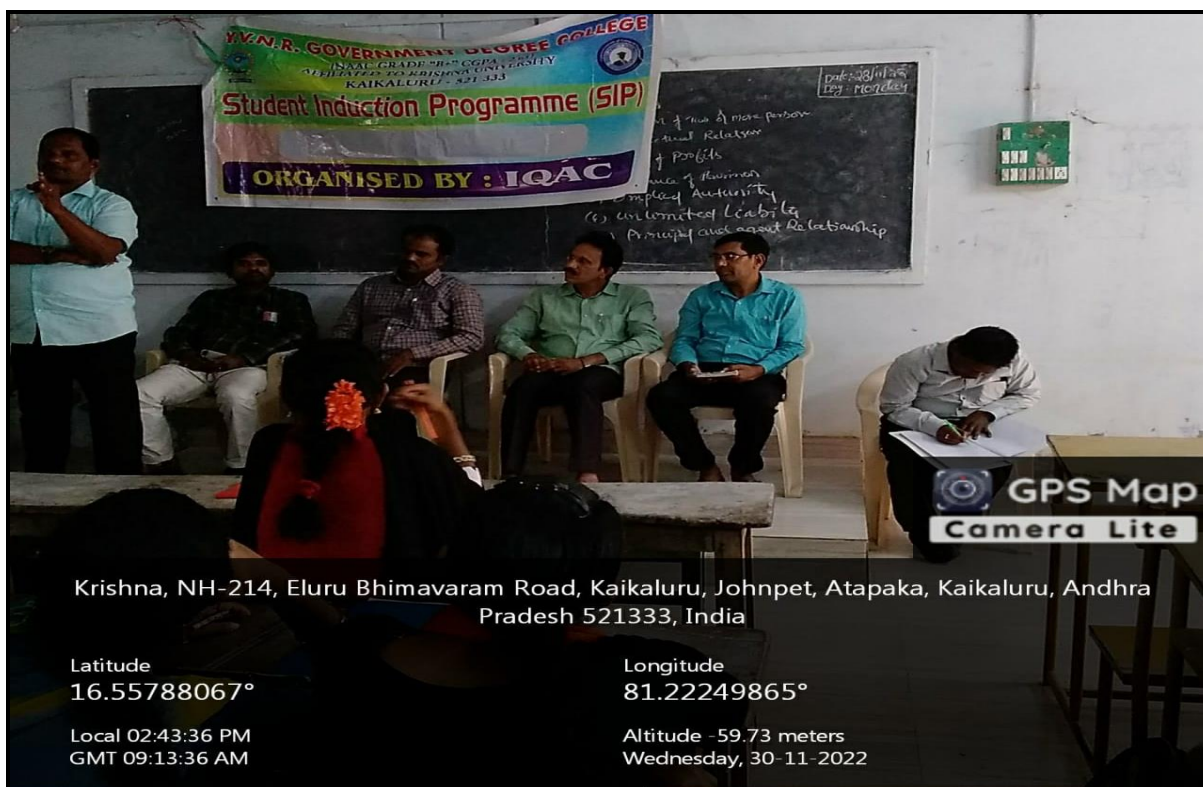

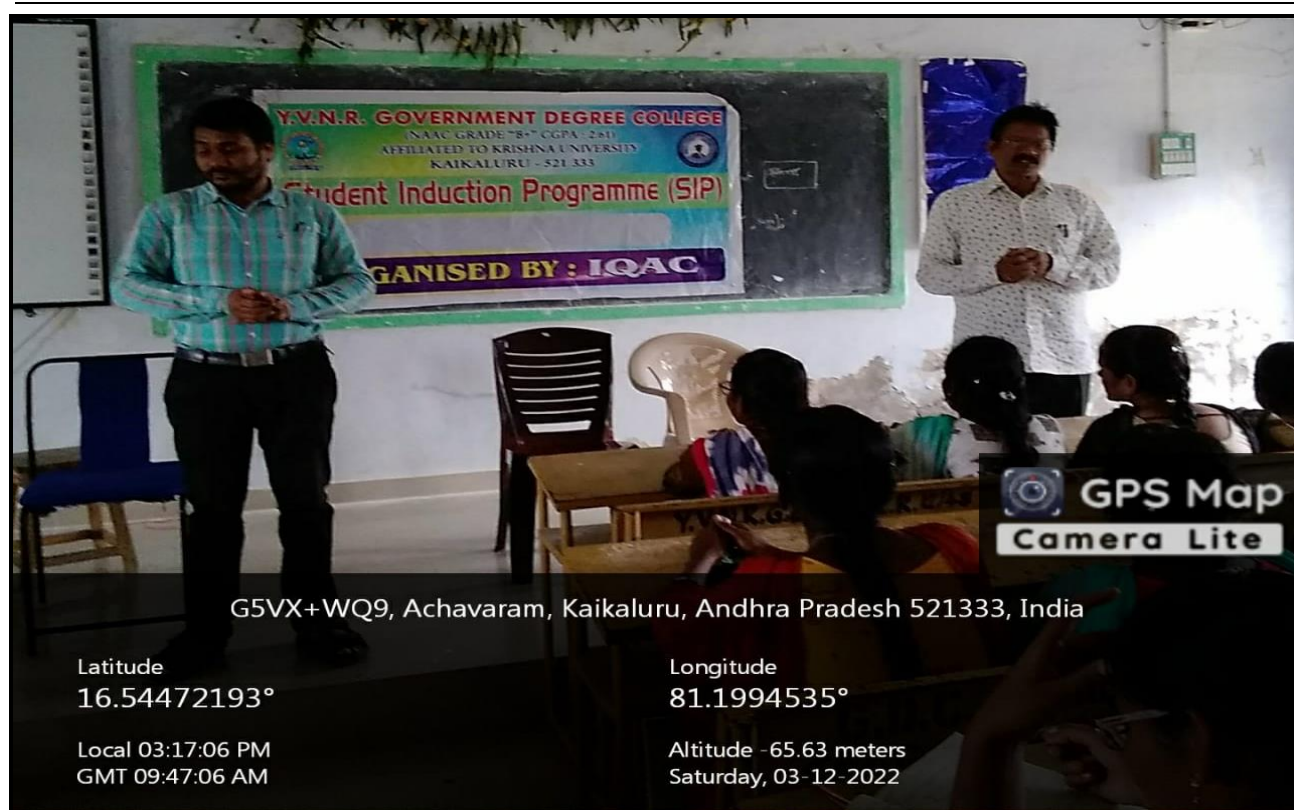

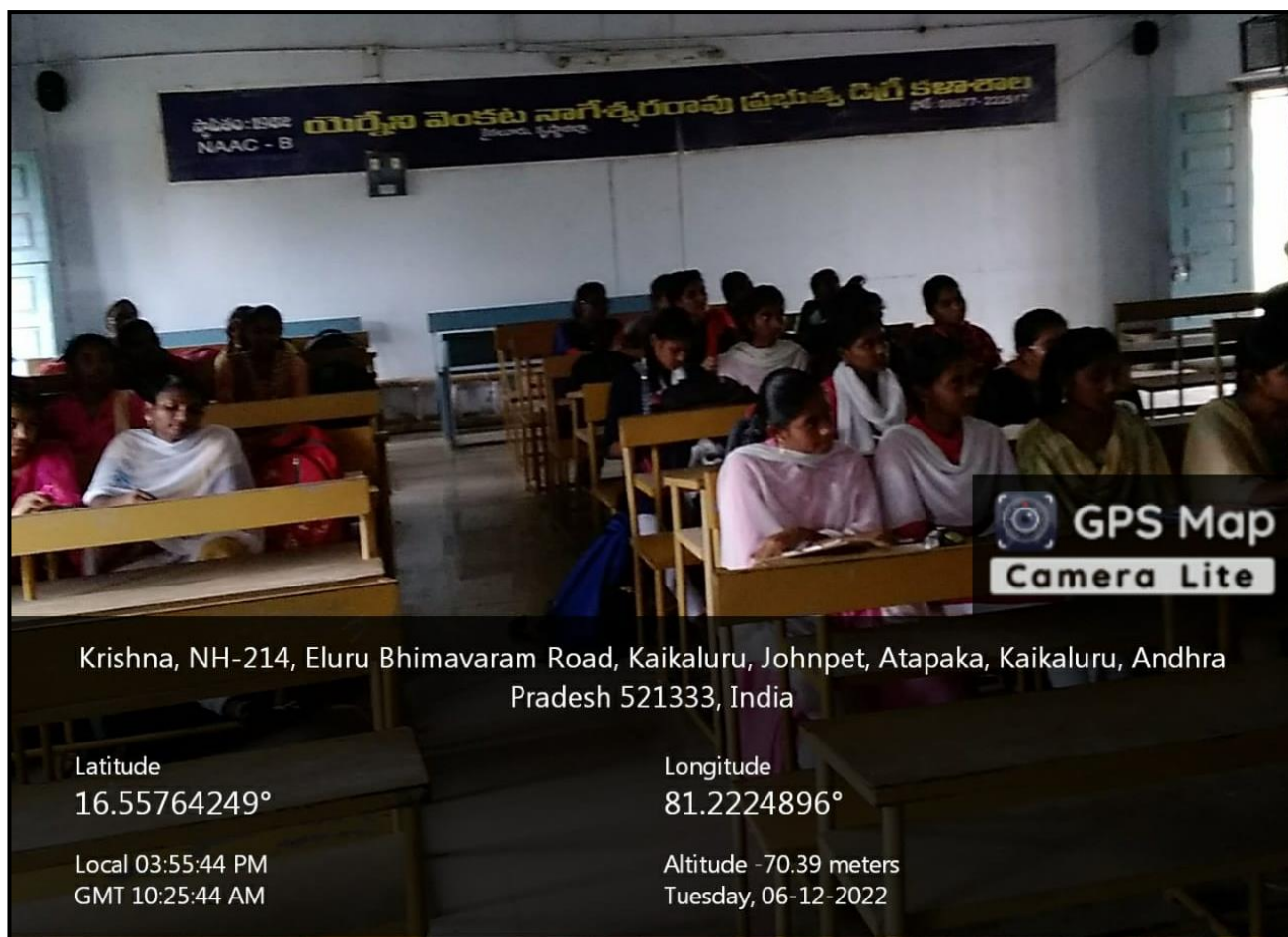
(CCE-LMS, Certificate Courses, Online Courses and NAAC)
